To our students, Autaugaville Christian Academy is more than a school. We are also a family, a community, and an environment that fosters a Biblical word view in our students. Admission Policy

Autaugaville Christian Academy admits students without regard to race, color, national and ethnic origin to all the rights, privileges, programs and activities generally afforded or made available to students of the school. It does not discriminate on the basis of race, color, national and ethnic origin in its employment practices, administration of educational policies, admission and treatment of students, athletic and other school-administered programs.

Admission will be determined by the Admissions Committee based on a review of the information received from each applicant. All new students are required to provide complete application information before admission can be determined. Admission considerations will include entrance exam results, academic records, personal interviews, teacher recommendations, and discipline reports. All admitted students are accepted on a provisional basis and will be formally evaluated at the end of the first grading period.

As a private Christian School, Autaugaville Christian Academy reserves the right to ask any student to leave, at any time, for any reason when school administration believes it is in the best interest of the school. Autaugaville Christian Academy also reserves the right to refuse a student admission for the next school year. Additionally, Autaugaville Christian Academy reserves the right to ask a student to withdraw if the actions of a parent or guardian are not in keeping with the mission of the school.

Tuition Options

1. Annually – The entire year's bill paid by July 1.
2. Bi-annually – Two payments per year due by July 1 and December 20, 2026
3. Monthly payments with 6-, 9-, 10- or 12-month options

Financial Assistance

Autaugaville Christian Academy is funded by the generosity of corporate donors, family foundations, individual donors, grants, and scholarships.

Additionally, Autaugaville Christian Academy is proud to be an Education Service Provider with the Alabama CHOOSE Act (Creating Hope & Opportunity for Our Students' Education Act). This program provides Education Savings Accounts to help Alabama families cover tuition and qualified educational expenses to support the success of eligible students in Alabama.

Eligible families can receive \$7,000 per participating student enrolled at Autaugaville Christian Academy. Participating families will be able to renew at the end of each school year, with priority given to families that have already participated.

At Autaugaville Christian Academy, we believe every child deserves a place where they can grow academically, emotionally and spiritually. This program helps make that possible.

Past Due Accounts

Tuition payments are due on the 1st of each month. A late fee of \$10.00 will be added to accounts after 10 days. If an account is not paid within 30 days, the child may be asked to leave the school. There will be an insufficient funds fee policy of \$40 per item returned.

Additional Information

When a child enrolls at Autaugaville Christian Academy, a place is reserved for them for the entire year. When a change during the school year is unavoidable, tuition charges will be pro-rated on a daily basis. Report cards and transcripts will be released to students, parents, or other schools once the student's account is paid in full.
